

## **The King is coming!**

### Summary

Read John 14: 1 – 3. and Titus 2:11-14. Jesus is the king and He will come again. Jesus came (1<sup>st</sup> appearing) and this was to save us through His grace. He will come again (2<sup>nd</sup> appearing) to take us to be with him for His glory.

The gospel which is good news is not complete without the message of Jesus' return. This needs to be included as part of the gospel. This is the message of hope to believers (Romans 15:4). We know that the apostles used to encourage one another by saying: Christ has died, Christ has risen and Christ will come again.

This message is a challenge to those who have not yet received him – Jesus is coming for his own, otherwise known as the bride or the church. But there is time. John 1: 12 tells us that all who receive him and believe in him have the right to be children of God.

Jesus' return is not just an inspirational message. It is also practical and requires us to: a) trust him b) have an eternal perspective c) expect his return and d) talk about it.

### Questions:

1. What did God say to you on Sunday and what are you going to do about it?
2. Does Jesus coming back give you hope? Why?
3. Are you eagerly expecting Jesus' coming? Why?
4. Is it easy or difficult for you to trust Jesus? Why?
5. Do you think Jesus' return is less talked about now than in the past? Why is this the case?
6. Is it difficult to have an eternal perspective today? Why?
7. How do you talk about Jesus' return with people you know?
8. Is there anyone you wish to pray for to hear this message?
