

Word notes for the cell meeting following Sunday 25th May

Who is he to you?

Read: Matthew 16:13-18

Summary:

As Jesus approaches the end of his ministry on earth it becomes imperative that his disciples have a true understanding of who he is, and so while in the vicinity of Caesarea Philippi he asks them a question 'Who do you say I am'?

Who is He to you?

The disciples had so much to say about what Jesus was to others, but Jesus knew that what mattered most was the personal revelation/understanding that *they* had of him. Having a personal revelation of God is born out of an intimate walk with Jesus. It involves laying down our own burdens and taking up those of Jesus. God unveils himself to us as we take his own yoke upon us.

1. Was there anything shared that needs clarifying?
2. What did God say to you and what are you going to do as a result?
3. What name(s) or attribute(s) best describes who Jesus is to you?
4. In what ways does God Speak to you? (b) How do we learn to recognize God's voice?
5. How best can we let go of burdens and yokes and take up those of Jesus
6. Pray for each other to have more of the Holy Spirit in your lives to reveal more about who Jesus is and what He's done for us.
